II. PARKING NEAR THE TRACK AND ON THE CAMPING SITE

Parking near the track

There will be limited parking at the event site. Please do not travel with a lot of cars to the event site from the camping. ONLY passenger vehicles are allowed and a maximum of 4 vehicles per team will be allowed on the parking for the teams at the event site. No trucks, vans, etc. transporting the team's equipment will be allowed to park in the parking area next to the track.

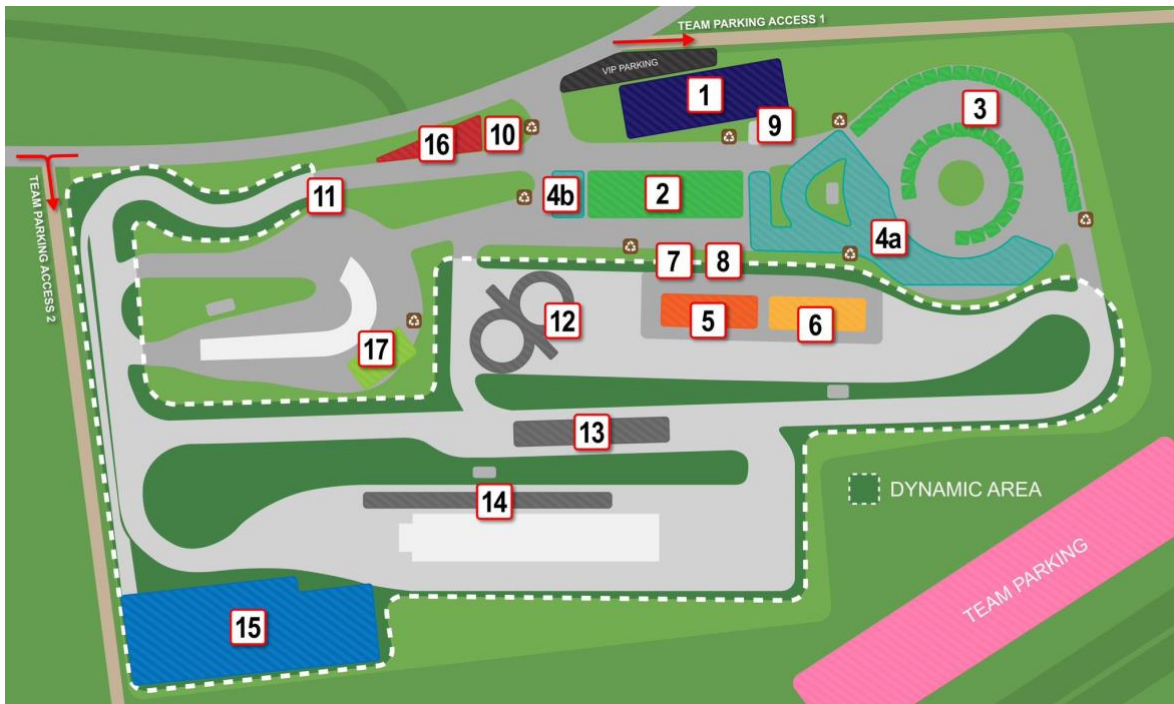
Parking area for trucks and vans is a parking under surveillance on the following location: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/oxvxviKj7Atmf1PV6>

Every team will get 4 parking passes at the registration for 4 cars which can park on the event site parking. Please put the parking pass on the windshield glass to be visible from outside.

Please be aware that the parking is limited and that penalty points can be given for misbehaving in the parking.

IV. TEAM REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION ON THE SPOT

The team first arrives at the track to the registration office/info point located at the Event Central [1] – see map of the track for more information regarding the exact location. Only the team captain accompanied by one team member will be allowed to do the team registration.

The team should bring a filled out Waiver of Liability (template available on the official website) to the registration and a deposit [€50] for the dynamic/media vests. The deposit for the data loggers [€250] will be collected later (the teams will be informed on time).

For drivers and ESOs the IDs will be checked before handing out the bands. Drivers and ESOs can come to the registration office after the registration of the team to pick up their bands and to identify themselves with an ID. This will be possible for the whole duration of the event.



MOVING INTO THE PITS/CAMPING SITE

During the team registration, you will get further information about your move into the pits/camping site. The pits as the camping spots will be assigned to every team in front, no rule first come - first serve. Moving into the pits and camp will be possible immediately after the team registration on the 20th of August.

Every team will have about 20 minutes to unload their equipment on the track and to move the vehicle/s outside of the event area. After the unloading of the vehicle/s, the team can move into the camping site where the parking for all vehicles will be - trucks, vans, and passenger cars not needed on the track.

It is allowed for the team to parallelly move into the pits and the camping site if announced at the registration and approved by the officials.

Please be patient! There is no need to hurry since we have a whole day for registration, and moving into the pits, we will do everything in time as we did in the previous years, and enjoy the process.

V. CAMPING SITE INFORMATION AND RULES

The camping spots for every team will be approx. 15x15 m (according to the team size by the TMRF).

Each team gets one electrical outlet socket (230V, 16A, 50 Hz, Type C a.k.a. "EU connection") on the electrical cabinet and they must pull the extension cords to the spot (max. distance from the cabinet to the spot is 25 m). All electric cabinets have a plastic bag/cover on them - after connecting to the electricity, put the bag/cover back on the cabinet.

IMPORTANT: It is strictly forbidden to use damaged equipment e.g. torn or patched cables, etc. All extension cords and other types of electrical connections must be protected from the rain/dew/moisture in a way that they are wrapped in a plastic bag and elevated from the ground (on a bench, chair or something else). Failure to follow the mentioned rules may result in injuries, damage to the equipment and even worse, penalty points.

Cooking is allowed and must be done under the supervision of a team member. Cooking with the fire (gas, wood) must be done in controlled conditions - not near flammable objects and not in a closed tent. All cooking equipment must be turned off and secured when not in use (gas grills, gas cylinders, etc.)

Smoking is allowed on the camping site, but the cigarettes must be extinguished and properly disposed of into the trash bins.



After arrival, remove all vehicles from the camp to the parking lot unless otherwise approved by the Camp manager.

Clean up after yourself! This goes for all parts of the camp - camp spot, showers, toilets, stations for washing dishes.

Playing loud music near the shower/toilet area is not allowed as it is close to residential houses.

Do not leave valuable things unattended, we are not responsible for any losses.

Please do not leave the camp with loose tent tightening's! Make sure to set up your camp properly in case of rain and wind.

Your camping spot is also part of the event so penalty points can be given for any misbehaving on the camping site.
