I. GENERAL

Formula Student Alpe Adria (FSAA) is an official Formula Student competition held in Velika Gorica, Croatia. The official rules of the competition are Formula Student Rules 2025 published [here](#).

FSAA 2025 will have two classes: CV (HV) and EV. Hybrid vehicles (HV) are a part of the combustion vehicle category.

This year's competition will be held from the 11th of August until the 17th of August 2025 on the Bugatti Rimac Test Track in Velika Gorica, Croatia. Further information, i.e. a detailed schedule at the event site etc. will be published before the event.

For FSAA 2025 there are 20 CV slots with Hybrid class included and 45 EV slots + 5 Alumni teams.*

Alumni do not need to register on the website or solve a quiz. We incite all of the interested teams should write to hello@fs-alpeadria.com and express their interest.



II. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

GENERAL

Every team must be registered on the official websites of FSAA and FSG. If two teams from the same University want to attend, each team must register separately.

RESERVED SLOTS

For the three overall CV and EV winning teams from FSAA 2024 a slot for 2025 is reserved. These are the following:

CV Class	EV Class
1. MoRe Modena Racing Hybrid	1. TUG Racing
2. Aristotle Racing Team	2. ELBFLOPANCE
3. BME Motorsport	3. munichM Motorsport

*Above teams must still create an account and solve a quiz if they wish to enter the competition.

vFSAA slots

Reserved spots for winners and collaborators on vFSAA (PoISI Racing, BME Motorsport, MART Malaga Racing Team & MAD Formula Team).

Regional slots

Reserved slots for the teams from the following countries: Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, North Macedonia, Serbia, Slovenia.

FSAA Hall of Fame - Waiting list priority

Priority on the waiting list for the teams that won FSAA in the past or that were on FSAA more than three times.

NOTE: Even if the team falls under the category of “reserved slots” it is obligatory for them to create an account and participate in the FSAA 2025 quiz, so that the organization is aware of the team’s interest in the competition and to secure the reserved spot.

TEAM PROFILE

ALL Team Accounts from 2024 have been disabled. Please make a new team account for your team even though you already made one before the publishing of this document.

To create a team profile, go to the FSAA website and click on the “profile icon” in the top right corner, and register a new account for the team.

The information needed for account creation:

- Team Captain’s Name
- Username for the website
- Team’s Email
- Password
- Team Captain’s Phone number (with country code)

NOTE: Make sure to confirm your account via confirmation email. Please wait up to 30 minutes for the email to arrive. Check your spam and junk folders.

After successfully activating the account, you need to register your team. Sign in the account and register your team under ‘Team Info’ tab.

Following information is needed for registration:

- Team Name (Full name)
- School/University Name (Full name)
- FSG ID*
- Country
- Class participating (EV/CV/CV(Hybrid))
 - If CV (HV) - FTO is needed (E85 or RON100)
- Car number (select from the dropdown list)
- Number of team members (can be changed before the competition)
- Organization name
- Organization Billing Address
- Organization VAT ID



Please note the following:

- The billing address is used for all fees (i.e. registration, team members & campsite fees)
- The fuel type order (FTO) is necessary information, which must be provided by every CV class including CV Hybrid class, so this cannot be changed after the registration. If any changes must be done after registration, especially changing fuel type between E85 and RON100, please contact hello@fs-alpeadria.com

CAR NUMBERS

The desired car number will be given in order of the quiz results, i.e. the better your teams scores on the quiz, the higher the chances to get the desired number. The car numbers will be published in the final list of teams registered for FSAA 2025.

Car numbers for CV:

104-999

The numbers 101-103 are reserved for top 3 teams from 2024.

Car numbers for EV:

E04-E99

The numbers E01-E03 are reserved for top 3 teams from 2024.

REGISTRATION FOR CV & EV

Each team needs to complete a registration quiz for the FSAA 2025 competition. To access the quiz every team must make a profile on the website first. Without a profile, your team will not be eligible to participate in the competition.

On the 31st of January at 17:00 CET a link to the quiz will be published on the competition's website, under the Team's profile (Quiz tab) with all the needed instructions. The teams will get a set of questions (all at the same time) and a limited time to solve it.

The scoring will be based on correctly answered questions – time of upload will only be taken in the account if two teams will happen to have the same score. The quiz answers will not be counted if the quiz is submitted after the deadline. Upload deadline will be specified on the quiz.

We recommend you submit the solutions a few minutes before the deadline, if you miss the deadline or suffer a computer error, it is your responsibility, and we will not make any exceptions.

If there are any files to be uploaded at the quiz, please use the following naming scheme: FSGID_TeamName_UniversityName_FSAA25_Quiz.xxx

Close-to-correct-answers: If the correct answer to a question is 0,98 and we said to round it to 2 decimal numbers, the answers like 1 or, 0,99 or 0,97 will not be accepted. If the answer is 524 and we said to round it to whole number, answers 523,85 or 524,01 will also not be accepted.

The final list of teams for FSAA 2025 will be published on our website, after all the payments will be finalized.



PAYMENT & REFUND POLICY

After the team's registration to the competition, every team will receive an invoice on the email address used for the team profile. The invoice will include details from the team's profile created on the website.

The cost for the competition for CV & EV teams is 4250 € with the camping site fee included for 15 team members.

Every additional team member is an additional 100 €.*

In case a team withdraws or is deregistered from the competition, 75% of the registration fee will be refunded until May 15th.

*The exact number of team members has to be announced at least 2 weeks prior to the competition (via TMRF). After submitting the TMRF the team has to pay for the additional team members with a new invoice created by the FSAA Association.

After the registration has finished, FSAA will send out invoices to the teams which made it on the final list. The deadline for payment is the 6th of February 2025 at 23:59 CET. After this date, the teams which did not pay for the competition or did not send a proof of payment to FSAA will lose their slot and the next team on the waiting list will be contacted.
